INFORMATION FOR TEAMS BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT

Arrival

Car parking will be an issue at Martin Luckie Park. Please forward the attached map showing the nearest carparks to your teams in advance. The closest are at Mt. Albert Park and the National Hockey Stadium. We highly recommend not trying to park on Lavaud Road as it is a narrow residential street and quickly becomes clogged. There will be parking attendants to help with parking directions.

Coaches Briefing

There will be a coaches briefing on Saturday morning at 8.15am and Sunday morning at 8.45am sharp in front of the caravan that will be alongside the tennis courts at Martin Luckie Park (an alternative location will be notified if it is raining). You will be given an information pack which will include the draw.

The pack will also include **result cards** which need to be returned to the caravan after each game. A participation ribbon for each player will also be included in the pack.

On Saturday, each grade has two pools. Please see the provisional draw sheets for your team's start time of either 9.00am or 9:30am. On Sunday all pools start at 9.30am.

Field numbers are marked and a map of the field numbers will be included in your information pack and posted outside the caravan. We will also email a field map later this week once the City has marked them.

Tournament Rules

Additional rules for the tournament:

To allow all-level teams to enjoy the day, any games reaching an 8 goal lead will freeze the score and play the remainder of the game with mixed teams using bibs.

Grade 7 and 8 mixed and 7/8 and 9/10 GO teams can have up to 9 players and Grade 9 and 10 mixed and 11/12 GO can have up to 11 players. Teams must only include players of the correct age officially able to play in that grade according to Capital Football.

Games will be two 10 minutes halves with a 2 minute break at half time.

Line Markings – the field markings may be hard to see – Referees would be best to have sideline refs identified at the start of the game to help identify when the ball goes out.

Pools will be played as a round robin. Each pool will have a winning team. Teams will gain 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and no points for a loss.

The winning team will be the team with the most points, if two teams have the same points at the end of the round robin, the winner will be determined by the following tiebreakers:

- team with the biggest goal differential, if still tied then;
- team with the most goals scored, if still tied then;
- winner of the head to head between the two teams, if still tied then;
- a coin toss.

Pools will be allocated taking into account each teams reported Capital Football grading at the end of the season or best judgement if it is a team of mixed players from a club.

Facilities

A sausage sizzle and drinks stall will be located near the facilities block. A Kaffee Eis cart will also be located near the facilities block with coffee and gelato for sale. Please help support our club by using these facilities. Separate male and female toilets are also available.
